## Terms and Conditions

By attending the Wild Women Grow Festival, I acknowledge that I am participating at my own risk. I understand that the festival organizers and property owners are not responsible for any liability, and I also agree to indemnify and hold harmless the festival organizers and those connected with the event from any claims for liability, injury, death, loss, or damage arising from my participation. In case of an emergency, I understand that the festival organizers shall not be responsible for providing me with medical care on site, and I will come prepared with my own first aid kit.

I release the festival organizers and those connected with the event from any responsibility or liability for loss and damages to my vehicle while parked in the designated parking lot or anywhere on the event property. I confirm that my vehicle has current and effective liability insurance.

I understand that soliciting products or services unless approved by the festival organizers is strictly prohibited. Only approved vendors may sell merchandise on festival grounds.

I will hold the highest vibration of love, unity, respect, and love for everyone in attendance and will be asked to leave without compensation if found in violation of this.

Photographers and videographers will be capturing the event, and I hereby give my consent to have my photo taken and used for future marketing purposes on behalf of the festival, as long as it does not contain any nudity or partial nudity. Attendees are welcome to take photos for personal use only.

All tickets and passes are non-refundable and the sole property of Wild Women Grow. WWG will not be responsible for lost tickets or passes and will not issue replacement tickets or passes. Refunds will not be issued for any reason, including if the event is cancelled due to acts of nature or government regulation, or if unable to use tickets due to illness, public health crisis, government restrictions, travel-related problems, or other conditions beyond the control of Wild Women Grow.

The Wild Women Grow Festival intends to gather, rain or shine. However, the festival is not liable for the weather, protests, or actions taken by government agencies and similar causes that may interfere with the event. Tickets are nonrefundable even if the festival is terminated early or cancelled due to harsh weather, acts of nature, governmental regulation, the failure to obtain required governmental permits, or conditions beyond the control of Wild Women Grow.

A ticket is a revocable license that may be revoked at any time, for any reason, without compensation.

If a dispute arises out of or relates to the festival and these terms and conditions, the parties agree to try to settle the dispute by mediation first. If a party fails to respond to a written request for mediation within 30 days after service or fails to participate in any scheduled mediation conference, that party shall be deemed to have waived its right to mediate the issue.
